



Free Home Safety Visit

At Devon and Somerset Fire and Rescue Service we aim to keep communities safe by providing free help and advice to prevent fires occurring. The damage caused by a fire in the home has devastating consequences and many incidents we attend could have been easily prevented.

What is a Home Fire Safety Visit?

A FREE Home Fire Safety Visit involves a Fire and Rescue Service employee visiting your home to give advice and guidance. They can help with the following home safety needs:

- Fit **FREE** smoke detectors where detectors are not already present.
- Provide advice about potential hazards in the home.
- Talk through an escape plan for your property.
- Provide additional safety items (subject to criteria)

Who is eligible?

The service is offered to persons and places that we know are at a greater risk from accidental dwelling fires. These include:

- Persons over 55
- Persons living alone
- Living with a disability
- Have young children in the property
- Are a smoker

National research has shown us that a combination of the above factors can significantly increase the chance of an accidental dwelling fire occurring.
